the said Geo: Jackson do for myself & Comp^{rs} our heirs & assigns hereby
renew release & forever discharge the said Thomas Brown his heirs & assigns
of & from all Clauses Coven^{ts} & Claims whatsoever that may any
wise arise against the said Brown his heirs & assigns by occasion of
the within mentioned Mortgage or any thing therein contained having had
full satisfaction as of & as Witness my hand & seal the 14th day of August Anno

lett & to farm lett as by these presents the said Charles doth demise grant lett &
to farm lett unto him the said Bay^{rs} & to his assigns all these two lots of
ground with the dwelling house & dwelling house thereupon built situate lying &
being in the port of Amherst with all & singular the appurtenances & all houses offices
stables gates gardens & all other easements & commodities to the same two
houses belonging or appertaining or with the same occupied with all & singular
their appurtenances & all things & vessels utensils & implements to the same
two houses belonging in any manner of wise appertaining to have hold use
occupy possess & enjoy the said lots of ground with the dwelling house & dwelling house
thereupon built & all other the premises therein before mentioned & expressed
together with their & every of their appurtenances to the said Bay^{rs} & to his assigns
or assigns from the day of the date hereof for & during the term of three years
fully to be completed & ended yielding & paying herefor yearly & every year
during the said term unto the said Charles his heirs or assigns the sum of
