

This Indenture made the second day of October In the year of our Lord  
 God one thousand seven hundred & three & in the second year of the Reigne of our  
 Sovereign Lady Anne by the Grace of God of England the Queen Betwixen John Gadsby of  
 the County of Ann Arundell in the province of Maryland planter of the one part and  
 Aaron Rawlins of the said County & province planter of the other part Witnesseth  
 that whereas Thomas Brown of the said County by Indenture under his hand &  
 Seale bearing date the second day of May one thousand seven hundred did for the  
 Consideration therein mentioned Grant Bargain Sell & convey unto the said John  
 Gadsby his heirs & assigns forever a Certain Tract or parcel of Land called Browns  
 Adventure lying in Baltimore County on the North side of Delapascoe River & on the  
 North side of the land of John Thomas Taylor Beginning at a bounded red Oak  
 in the said Thomas Taylor line it being a bounded tree of Richard Cwing  
 & running with the said Taylor line South East three hundred twenty feet  
 to a bounded white Oak by a Run called Davies Run then North East three  
 hundred fifty six feet then North West six hundred & eighty feet then  
 South West one hundred fifty feet then South East three hundred &  
 fifty feet then by a straight line to the first bounded red Oak containing  
 & laid out for one thousand acres of Land as by the said Indenture may more at  
 large appear And whereas the said John Gadsby did by Indenture under his  
 hand & Seale Sell & convey unto John Barker of Baltimore County one hun-  
 dred & thirty acres of Land part of the said Tract of Land called Browns  
 Adventure to be conveyed to the said John Gadsby as aforesaid the whole containing one  
 thousand acres under certain bounds & limits in the said deed contained  
 Now This Indenture Witnesseth that the said John Gadsby for use & in Consideration  
 of the sum of one hundred & five pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by  
 the said Aaron Rawlins the receipt whereof the said John Gadsby did acknowledge  
 acknowledge & show of & of every part & parcel thereof both fully Brown to  
 acquit & discharge the said Aaron Rawlins his heirs & assigns for ever hath given  
 Granted Bargain Sell Aloud Insooth & confirmed And by these presents he doth  
 give Grant Bargain Sell Aloud Insooth & confirm unto the said Aaron Rawlins  
 his heirs & assigns for ever all that then remaining part of the aforesaid Tract  
 of Land called Browns Adventure containing by Estimation Eight hundred &  
 seventy Acres the aforesaid one hundred & thirty Acres of Land to be conveyed to the  
 said John Barker being Excepted out of the whole which containe one thousand  
 Acres as aforesaid to have & to hold the said remaining part of the said Tract of Land  
 called Browns Adventure containing Eight hundred & seventy Acres the said one  
 hundred & thirty Acres to be conveyed to the said Barker as aforesaid being Excepted out of  
 the whole which containe one thousand Acres as aforesaid with all houses dwelling  
 houses Out houses
