

and no more what persons so chosen and appointed by you
 shall do to all intents and purposes Commissions in our said
 Province until either they shall be confirmed by us or if by the
 nomination of others by us under our Great Seal and Signet
 our said Council shall have more or more persons in it And we
 do hereby give and grant unto you full power and Authority with
 the advice and Consent of our said Council from time to time as
 need shall require to Summons and Call General Assemblies of the
 said Freeholders and Pleaders within your Government according
 to the usage of our Province and Territory of Maryland

And we will and pleasure it is of the persons thereupon duly
 elected by the Major part of the Freeholders of the Respective Counties
 and Places and Districts and having before their taking taken
 the oaths appointed by act of Parliament to be taken instead of the
 Oaths of Allegiance and Supremacy and the oaths mentioned in the
 forsaide Act entitled an Act to declare the Abolition in the said
 appointed to be taken by the said Act entitled An Act for the further
 Security of his Majesty's Person and the Succession of the Crown in the
 Protestant Line and for relinquishing the hopes of the pretended
 Prince of Wales and all other pretenders and their open and secret
 adherers and for declaring the Abolition to be determined as also
 the forsaide said Acts which oaths you shall Commissionals fill
 down under our Seal of Maryland to Administer to unto them
 and without taking of which oaths and Test none shall be capable
 of taking the Oaths shall be called and hold the general Assembly
 of the Province and if you the said John Seymour by and with
 the advice and Consent of our said Council and Assembly or the
 Major part of them respectively have full power and Authority
 to make Constitutions and Ordains Laws Statutes and Ordinances for the
 publick
