

Admiral of England for the time being may be tried and punished according to
 the Laws of that Place where any such disorders and misdemeanors shall be
 committed on Shore notwithstanding such offenders be in our actual Service and
 in our pay on board any such Our Ships of War or other Vessels acting by
 Immediate Commission or Warrant from our High Admirals of England or
 from our Commissioners for executing the office of High Admirals for the
 time being as aforesaid So as he shall not receive any protection (for the
 avoiding of Justice) for such offences committed on Shore from any presence
 of his being employed in our Service at Sea And our further will and plea-
 sure is of also publick Monies raised or which shall be raised by any act here-
 after to be made within our said provinces to be used by Warrant from your
 Grace with the advice and Consent of our said Council and disposed off by
 you for the support of the Government and not otherwise And we do
 hereby give you full power and Authority to appoint fairs Markets and Mark-
 ets as also such and so many Ports Harbours and other places for the
 Convenience and Security of Shipping and for the better Loading and unload-
 ing of goods and Merchandises as by you with the advice and Consent of
 our said Council shall be thought fitt and necessary And we do hereby
 Command all Officers and Ministers Civil and Military and all other what-
 soever of our said provinces and Territory to be Obedient aiding and
 assisting unto you the said John Seymour in the Execution of this our
 Commission and of the powers and Authorities therein contained and in case
 of your death or absence out of our said provinces to be Obedient aiding
 and assisting unto such person as shall be appointed by us to be Commanded or
 in chief of our said provinces to whom we do hereby give by these presents
 give and Grant all and singular the powers and Authorities to be seen
 and Enjoyed by him during our pleasure or until your arrival within our
 said provinces of Mary land And of upon the Death or absence of you the
 said John Seymour out of our said provinces of Mary land there be no
 other Commissioned or appointed by us to be Commanded in chief of our
 said provinces Our Will and pleasure is if there shall be present Council of that
 our provinces do take upon them the direction of the Government and execute
 this Commission and the full power and Authority therein contained and
