 March in the fourteenth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lord
 King William the third & c. Anno Domini 1701 Between John Jones of
 Peabottoms County Gentle & Elizabeth his wife of the one part &
 Wm Tylard of Amaranthold Esq^r Gentle of the other part
 Witnesseth that as well for the love & affection w^{ch} they the said
 John Jones & Elizabeth his wife have & bear towards the
 Children Wolfson Hunt & John Hunt sons of the said Eliz^a by
 one Wolfson Hunt lately deceased & as done. Son of the said John
 Elizabeth Jones lately called Elizabeth Hunt of the settlement of
 a certain tract of Land hereafter mentioned to use therein
 after expressed as also for & in consideration of a sum of
 five hundred shillings to them the said John Jones & Elizabeth his wife
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John
 Jones & Elizabeth his wife have given granted bargain'd & c.
 confirm'd & by these presents do give grant bargain'd & c.
 confirm unto the said Wm Tylard his heirs & assigns forever
 all that tract or parcel of Land called pushpin lying in
 Peabottoms County & on the Middle River of puttopent beginning
 at the first tree of Charles Carrolls Land called Decorgan running
 from the said tree North by West two hundred East by North
 one hundred & sixly paces South by East two hundred & fives then
 to the first tree containing two hundred acres more or less
 according to the survey as by patent remaining on record
 in the Land Office at Annapolis relation being thereunto
 had it doth & may more fully and at large appear together wth
 all the Woods Underwoods ways easements profits Commodities
 Emoluments & appurtes to the same belonging or in any wise
 appertaining and all the estate right title Interest & Claim of the
 said John Jones & Eliz^a his wife or either of them have of in or to the
 said Land & premises to have & to hold the said two hundred
 acres of Land & premises with their & every of their appurtes unto him
 the said Wm Tylard & his heirs forever to & for the several uses
