that they those Dep<sup>s</sup>. Did know <sup>here formerly acquainted with</sup> in the County of  
Leicester father of Theophilus Hackon w<sup>ch</sup> Theophilus  
Hackon was put to Trade of Shoemaker & after wards  
viz<sup>t</sup> in the yeares 1604 or 1605 those Dep<sup>s</sup>. Rememb<sup>r</sup>.  
they were credibly Informed that he lived in the province  
of Maryland & the Said Thomas Hathead of himself saith  
that he hath heard the Said Theophilus Hackon lived in  
Sovern River there & was marryed to one widow Skidmore  
and likewise they both those Dep<sup>s</sup>. were informed that  
the Said Theophilus Hackon Dyed possessed of a good estate  
in the Said province and further those Dep<sup>s</sup>. say that  
to the best of their Knowledge all the rest of the Children  
of the Said Thomas Hackon are Dead w<sup>ch</sup>oul<sup>d</sup> I say & that  
the Said Thomas Hackon had but one only Brother that  
lived to have I say whose name was W<sup>m</sup> Hackon w<sup>ch</sup>
