my Seal & dated the sixteenth day of March Anno Domini 1701.

The condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound
John Jones his Ex^{rs} or Adm^{rs} or either of them do & shall not
truly satisfy deliver & pay unto the said Wolfran Hunt & John Hunt
at the time they shall attain to the age of four & twenty years two
Cows w^{ch} calves by their sides or two Cows with calf to each of them of
said Wolfran & John to hold them their heirs & Assigns for ever & also
two breeding cows to be delivered to each of the said children Wolfran &
John at the time they attain to the age of four & twenty years as afo-
re said cows & calves & breeding cows are to be delivered as afo-
