 and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred and twenty
 of England to them the said Thomas Williams and Elizabeth his
 wife in hand by the said Wm. Taylor paid or by his the
 Executor and Assigns of the said Wm. Taylor the receipt whereof
 they do hereby acknowledge and themselves to be satisfied with
 fully satisfied and they do acquit release and discharge
 the said Wm. Taylor in hand received and admit for done
 by these presents HAVE given granted bargain and sold
 unto the said William Taylor all that tract or parcel
 of Land with the appurtenances commonly called or known by
 the name of Wicks ab Dandy lying on the western
 shore in Baltimore County and on the South side of a
 branch of a River called the North East River and on
 the North East side of the said branch beginning
 at a mark in the ground in a bay by a mark the
 running of the said East River for breadth
 three hundred and fifty perches to a mark Malberry tree
 standing on a low point of marsh on the East side and
 drawn North and by East from the said Malberry tree
 length three hundred and fifty perches on the North by a
 line drawn west North west from the end of the North
 end by East line for breadth three hundred and fifty
 perches on the west by a line drawn South and by west
 from the end of the west North west line unto the first
 mark in the South by the said River containing
 seven hundred acres of Land more or less as by Certificate
 thereof bearing date the seven and twentieth Day of
 September one thousand six hundred fifty nine and
