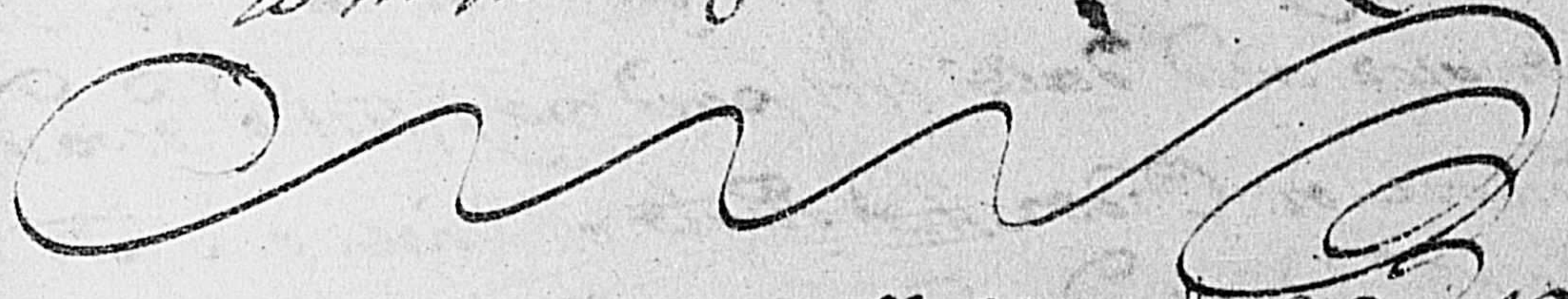

 Amherst County Sheriff or either of them our true & lawfull
 Attorney or Attorneys for us & in our name either in the Court
 or Gallies County Court or before two Justices of the Court
 or said County Court to appear & acknowledge the within
 mentioned good to the said W. Esquire according to Act of
 Assembly in that Case made & provided And wee the said
 Thomas & Elizabeth for the consideration within mentioned
 do by this Endorsement Grant & Remise to the said W. Esquire
 & his heirs the within Land to be holden of this & their right
 against us & our heirs for ever without our hinder & delay
 the twentieth day of July Anno Domini 1703.
