 thousand seven hundred & four between Richard Clark of Am-
 erindole County in the province of Maryland Gent of the one part
 & Gabriel parrot of the said County planter of the other part Witnesseth
 that the said Richard Clark for in consideration of the sum of
 eight hundred & forty pounds sterl currant & lawful money of
 England to him in hand paid by the said Gabriel parrot before
 the swearing & delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the doth
 hereby acknowledge & the wife of every part & parcel thereof doth
 hereby for him his heirs &c. & adm^{rs} clearly & absolutely acquit-
 & discharge the said Gabriel parrot his heirs & assigns
 for ever hereupon, granted Aliene Bargain & sold Infesd. & held
 made over & confirmed as by these presents the doth hereby give Grant
 alien Bargain & sold Infesd. & confirm unto the said Gabriel
 parrot his heirs & assigns for ever all that & those the Town Land
 Tract & plantations therein after mentioned (that is to say) the planta-
 tion or tract of Land between the said Clark now deceased, containing
 four hundred acres called Clark's Inheritance & a tract of Land called
 Elizabeth's Fancy containing two hundred twenty five acres & also a
 tract or parcel of Land called Clark's purchase containing fifty acres to the
 more full & perfecting & being in the said County of Am erindole
 (together
