This indenture made the twelfth
day of May in the fourteenth year of our Sovereign
Lord William by the Grace of God of England Scotland
France & Ireland King Defender of the Faith &c
Anno Domini 1702 between John Anderson of the County
of Dorset in the Province of Maryland planter of
the one part & John Howard of Ann Arundell County
in the Province of planter of the other part witnesseth
that the said John Anderson for & in consideration of
the sum of thirty pounds Sterling & one thousand five
hundred thirty & two pounds of Tobacco to him in
hand paid and before the signing & delivery hereof
the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge
& those acquitt & discharge the said John Howard
& for good Causes & Considerations him thereunto moving
have given granted Bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed
& confirmed & doth by these presents give grant alien
Bargain sell Enfeoff & confirm unto the said John Howard his
heirs & assigns to the only use & behoof of the said John
(Howard)
