

oak being the North west corner tree of the said Land & running south  
by West two hundred forty four perches with the line of Mr. Halls Land like  
it intersect the North line of Richard Smiths Land & from thence by  
a line drawn West bounded on the said Land for one hundred  
twenty eight perches to a bounded poplar being the North west corner  
tree of the said Land & from thence running by North west bounded  
by John Kings Land for one hundred & twenty ff<sup>t</sup> to a bounded white  
oak of the said John Kings Land from thence running West & by  
North thirty six ff<sup>t</sup> to a marked tree standing on the North side of  
the main branch of Lees Creek & from thence North one hundred  
twenty four perches to a bounded oak & from thence to the first tree  
containing & laid out for two hundred acres more or less the bounds  
of additional spitts followeth viz<sup>t</sup> Beginning at a bounded  
poplar it being the Southeast corner tree of a parcel of Land now  
in the possession of Mr. Loasworth called Timber wood & running  
with the said Land South west two hundred & forty ff<sup>t</sup> West intersect  
the line of a tract of Land now in the possession of Mr. Craycraft  
called Newington from thence running East with the said Land one hundred  
& twenty ff<sup>t</sup> West intersect the West line of the said Land called spitts & running  
with the said Land North one hundred & six perches to a bounded tree thence  
East with the said Land two hundred & forty ff<sup>t</sup> like it intersect a West line of  
another piece of Land of Mr. Eliza Halls called Hogdown & running with the  
said Land North & by East forty eight ff<sup>t</sup> to a bounded poplar then in West thirty eight  
feet to the first tree & laid out for one hundred thirty six acres more or less  
to have & to hold the said two tracts of Land with all the dwelling houses out-  
houses & other houses fences & all other the appurtes whatsoever thence unto belonging  
or in anywise appertaining unto him the said Edm<sup>d</sup> Henry Small his heirs
