 and whole power & authority in the Injuncts by
 force hereof In Witness whereof wee have
 herevnto sett our hands & Seals this Nineteenth
 Day of July Anno Dni 1699: And in the Eleaventh
 Year of reaigne of King William the Third our
 England &c.
