firmly bound unto our Sovereign Lady Queen Ann by the  
Grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland Defender  
of the Faith in the full sum and just Quantity of two hundred  
thousand pounds of good sound merchantable Rags and  
Cables to be paid to her Majesty her heirs and Successors to the  
which payment well and truly to be paid was bin our  
Selves and either of us our and either of our heirs Executors  
Soynties and Assigns for the whole and in the whole firmly by  
these presents as witness our hands & Seals this fourth day of  
Aug<sup>r</sup> in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of her Majesty's reign Anno Domini 1703

Roger Woolford do well and truly serve her Majesty her heirs and Successors  
in the office of High Sheriff of the said County of Dorchester within the  
province aforesaid and also shall render unto her said Majesty & other
