 severally for the whole term in this writte firmly by these presents as
 witness our hands & seals the second day of June in the second year
 of her Majestys Reigne Annoq^m 1703

The condition of this above obligation is such that if the above:

Counten Aquita paca dowels and truly serve her said Majesty her
 heirs & Successors in the office of High Sheriff of the said County of
 Baltimore within this province aforesaid and also shall render unto
 her said Majesty & either her said Officers a true faithful and exact
 account of all and singular her said Majestys Rights & dues and to her
 Officers a true and just account of their fees that he shall or may
 be entrusted with by her Majesty her heirs & either her said Majesty
 Officers within this province as to receive and collect and be answer-
 able to her said Majesty her heirs or Successors or to her or their heirs
 for the time being for the fines or forfeitures or other dues being
 owing to her said Majestys Government as also the account of all fees
 dues or summs of money or tolls or duties or fees due to any her said
 Officers & other good people within this province that he shall pass an account
 for by the tenth day of April next ensuing the date hereof and make
 oath as Sheriff of the said County of Baltimore that he shall discharge himself
 well and honestly towards all persons according to the best of his power
