bound unto our Sovereign Lady Queen Anne &c in the full
and just sum of two hundred thousand pounds of good Lawfull
Merchantable Saff lobacco and Casse to be payd to her said
Majesty her heirs and Successors to the which payment
wee and truly to be made and done wee and our heirs &c
either of us our and either of our heirs &c Adm^{rs} firmly by
these presents as witness our hands & Seals the seventh day
of September in the third year of her Majesty's Regn Anno -
Dom 1704

The condition of the above obligation is such that if the
above bound Roger Woolford do we and truly serve her Majesty
her heirs and Successors in the office of Sheriff of the
said County of Dorchester within this province aforesaid and shall
also render unto her said Majesty and either her said Officers a
true faithful and exact account of all and singular her said
Majesty's Right & dues and to her Off^{rs} a true and just Acco^t of the
Goods that he shall or may be intrusted with by her Majesty her
either her Off^{rs} within this province aforesaid to receive & collect &
his Acco^t to her said Majesty her heirs & Successors or to her or their
Governor for the time being for the funds and forfeitures &
other dues belonging to her said Majesty's Government as also this
Acco^t of all other dues or sums of money or to be for any or other
due to any of her Majesty's Off^{rs} & other good purposes within
this province shall pass an Acco^t for by the tenth day of April next
enouncing the date hereof and in all other things as suff^{ts} of the
said County of Dorchester shall behave themselves well and honestly
towards all & sund^r according to the best of their power &c
