 Wm. Brillon - Land out for Wm Brillon of this Province Gent
 500 Acres - a parcel of Land lying on y^e East side of Ches-
 peake bay and on y^e North side of a river in y^e-
 said Bay call'd Elk river Beginning at a mark'd
 oak standing upon a point call'd Plum point -
 running West South West down the river for
 breadth two hundred and fifty perches to a
 mark'd Chestnut tree by the river side bounding
 on the West by a hundred and North West & by
 North from the said Chestnut tree for length -
 three hundred & twenty perches on y^e North -
 by a hundred and North East and by East from
 the end of y^e North West by North for breadth -
 five hundred perches until it intersect a parallel
 drawn from a tree call'd Plum point creek
 on y^e East with the said tree and parallel
 on y^e South by y^e id river containing acres
 Land out for five hundred acres more or less
