This Indenture made the 17th day of April in the 13th year of the Dominion of our Right Honorable Charles the first and first of the Province of Maryland and Annapolis Baron of Baltimore the Agents Indenture between the Board of Selects of the County in the Province of Maryland Gent and Ann his of the one part and James Robinson of Cecil County planter of the other parts doth witness that whereas the said James Robinson of Cecil County in the Province of Maryland Gent son & heir of Mary his daughter and Heir of William his late of the said County Gent and Vice-Chancellor to the said James Robinson of the one part and of the Towels of the other part did by their deed of gift and bargain date the 13th day of May 1675 in consideration of the sum of five thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco in hand paid by the said Towels to the said James Robinson & Heir his wife and Heir his doth witness that the said Towels his Heir & Heir his doth give and grant unto the said James Robinson & Heir his wife and Heir his all that parcel of land with appurtenances thereto belonging situate lying & being on the East side of Chesapeake Bay & on the North side of the said Bay called the woods beginning at a marked oak standing upon a point called Plum Point running West South West down the river for breadth two hundred
