 This Indenture made y^e fifteenth day of March
 In the fifth year of the reign of our Sovereign Lady
 Anne by y^e grace of God of England Scotland France &
 Ireland Queen Defender of y^e faith &c Annoq^{ue} Domini
 1705 Between Samuel Dorsey of Annarundell County
 Gentleman of the one parte & Samuel Norwood
 of the same County Gentleman of the other parte &
 Witnesseth that whereas Col^l. Edward Dorsey did in
 his lifetime stand possessed & seized in his demesne
 as of ^{fee} and in a certain Tract of Land called Majors
 Choice situate lying and being in Baltimore
 County on Petafscoc River & the sd^o Edward Dor-
 sey being so seized as afores^d did by a Deed of
 Gift bearing date the ninth day of April One
 Thousand Seven hundred Duly Executed acknow-
 ledged & recorded Give Grant unto four of his
 Children four hund^d. Acres of Land out of y^e afo^r
 Tract of Land called Majors Choice (The whole &
 containing Eight hundred Acres be the same more
 or less)
