This Indenture made the sixteenth day of
april in the year of our lord one thousand seven
hundred Between James Murra of Baltimore
County in the province of Maryland planter of
the one part and Tho: Odell of Annapondell
County in the province aforesaid Gent^l of
the other part Witnesseth that whereas the
Right hon^{ble} Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore
absolute lord and proprietor of the province of
Maryland and Avalon &c^a by his letters patents
bearing date the twelfth day of November one
thousand six hundred ninety five did grant unto
the said James Murra a certain tract of land
called Atholl Court and laid out for six hundred
and seven score acres and by his letters patents bearing
date the aforesaid twelfth day of November one thou
sand six hundred ninety five did grant unto the said James
Murra a certain tract of land called Murras addition
Court and laid out for eighty nine acres Both which
tracts are lying in Baltimore County on the north
side of Patuxent river and on a ridge called
Hunting ridge relations being had unto the patents
Both more at large app^r and now therefore these
presents Witnesseth that he the said James Murra
for and in consideration of the full sume of fifty
pounds for good and lawful money of England to
him the said James Murra in hand well and truly
paid by the said Tho: Odell at and before the exe
cution and delivery of these presents the receipt where
of the said Murra doth hereby acknowledge and
of words &c^a and parts thereof to be fully satisfied
contented and paid and the said Tho: Odell his heirs
Executors adm^r and assigns doth acquit & release
