The conditions of the above obligation is such that If the above Bounden Joseph Manning Dowell and Truly for ever her said Majesty her Heirs and Successors in the office of High Sheriff of the County of Charles within the province aforesaid and also shall render unto her said Majesty and other her officers a true & faithful effect Account of all and singular her said Majesty's Rights and Dues and to her officers a true and just acc<sup>t</sup> of the fees that he shall or may be entrusted with by her Majesty's Governour and other her officers within this province to receive and collect and his account to her said Majesty her Heirs and Successors to her & their Governour therefor the sum being for the fines and forfeitures and other Dues belonging to her said Majesty's Gov<sup>r</sup> as also his acc<sup>t</sup> of all other Dues & Sums of money or Tobacco Levys or fees due to any her Majesty's officers and other good people within the province shall pass an acc<sup>t</sup> of by the Fourth
