 do by these presents acquitt discharge the s^d Valentine for
 and from any right of Dower had or ought to have. By
 Vertue of my being the Lawfull wife of the above Rich^d
 Kirkland Ratifying and Confirming all and singular
 in foreours^d Attorney shall do or cause to be done
 in or about the premises as the s^d Valentine shall require
 as the Law direct in such Cases as fully amply and ab^{ly} doe
 by as if I or my Wife was present did it our selves & further
 do Impower you John Jones to take in all papers
 relating to me that now is in the possession of George
 Valentine concerning the above Land as also the
 protested bill of Exch^g for which the said Valentine has
 this Two Tracts of Land In Witness whereof
 we have hereunto sett our hands and Seals this Eleventh
 day of Octob^r 1708
