 said John Jones doth by these presents further covenant promise grant
 and agree to and w^t him the said Charles Carroll and his heirs that
 he paid two percell of Land and promises he will now and at all
 times hereafter wan^t defend unto him the said Charles Carroll his
 heirs & assigns for ever as all & all manner of persons wh^t also over
 provided alwayes and it do the true intent & Meaning of these presents
 that if the said John shall pay or cause to be paid unto the said
 Charles Carroll his & ad assignes the just and full sume of
 eighty one pounds four shillings being the consideration money
 above specified or the sume of one hundred and eight pounds five
 shillings four pence currant money of Maryland & and by such
 payment as are herein after expressed (viz) one third part thereof
 w^t Legall interest for the whole sume or consideration money aff or
 upon the tenth day of Octob^r next; and also aff or upon the tenth
 day of Octob^r then next foll^g; another third part of the said sume
 money w^t Legall interest for the two thirds then due And lastly
 aff or upon the tenth day of Octob^r which shall happen to be in the
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eleven the
 remnd third part then due w^t Legall interest for the same that
 then this deed and all articles, clyses and covenants thereon contain
 ed are to be void and of no effect otherwise to remaine absolute
 in full force & Value in Estin only whereof the said parties have
 herunto interchangably sett their hands & affixed their seals
