 last without issue that Anne is now married to Samuel Beckayn  
 of Gilling in the County of York afo<sup>r</sup> and Kingdom afo<sup>r</sup> Gent<sup>l</sup> both  
 now living that Mary is now married to Christopher Seaford  
 of Newcastle in the Kingdom afo<sup>r</sup> merchant both now living  
 that Sarah dyed some years before Richard her Uncle but  
 was married to Nathaniel Hargrave of Newcastle afo<sup>r</sup> the  
 Kingdom afo<sup>r</sup> Gent<sup>l</sup> now living that issue James & Mary  
 now living, that Thomas Carlor brother to the said Richard  
 Carlor late Citizen & Alderman of the City of York in the Kingdom  
 afo<sup>r</sup> dyed about twenty years ago and left issue Eliz<sup>th</sup> James  
 and Mary all now living that Eliz<sup>th</sup> is married to W<sup>m</sup>  
 Sankred of Arden in the County of York Kingdom afo<sup>r</sup> Esq<sup>r</sup>
