 Injurison and to Condemne and out of Prison againe to deliver  
 also to Compound Conclude and agree by arbitration or otherwise  
 as his said attorney shall thinke fitt. And Generally in  
 Concerning the premises to doo performe and execute all  
 whatsoever shall be requisite and Necessary as fully amply  
 and Effectually to all intents Instructions and purposes as the  
 said Constituant might or could doo person ally present  
 And that all the the Cause should require more speciall or  
 ample power then is herein before particularly Expressed  
 power to Substitute one or more attorneys under him with  
 like or limited power and the same againe to Revoke the  
 the said Constituant hereby promising to Ratify confirm hold  
 for good and Valid all and whatsoever his said attorney or his  
 Substitute shall Lawfully do or Cause to be done more about  
 the premises by the vertue of these presents Thus done & passed in
