

This Indenture made this Twenty fourth day of May
 in the year of our Lord God one thousand seven hundred and seven
 Between Stephen Gill of Amman and County of the one part
 and Charles Caroll of the same County of the other part Witnesseth
 that the said Stephen for and in consideration of the sum of thirty four
 ten shillings and five pence half penny paid to him in hand paid by the said Charles
 the Receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge that he hath given granted bargained
 sold and assigned over unto the said Charles Caroll All that tract or piece of Land
 called **Wynns** **Mane** lying on the south side of Amman and seven furlongs
 beginning at about a white oak in the north north west line of the Wharfed
 and joining with the said **Line** north north west and ending
 by the said **Line** to abouted Red oak of Jonas proportion then with the
 said proportion **Line** west and by South nearly by proportion South and by
 East one hundred twenty and six paces to abouted white oak of Edw. Gaudry
 then East three degrees South one hundred thirty and five paces to the first
 bounded white oak containing and laid out of muddy eight acres of Land
 together with five cows three heifers four yearlings and one young calf and
 two years old **Red** twenty head of hogs and one mare of **Red** to have
 to hold the said Land and Cattle hogs mare and Calf to him the said Charles by
 warrant against all persons whatsoever to be clear of all manner of **quit** **rents**
 whatsover provided always and it is the true intent and mean use of these
 presents that if the said Stephen his heirs or assigns shall well truly pay or
 cause to be paid the one moiety or half part of the above sum of a shilling upon the tenth
 day of April next which shall be in the year of our Lord seven hundred and seven
 and the other moiety the tenth day of April seven hundred and seven that then
 this deed and every Clause therein and the estate thereby given shall cease and
 determine In Witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands
