 said Robert Johnson doth hereby acknowledge and thereof
 and of every part and parcel thereof doth for himself his heirs
 Executors and assigns by these presents and absolutely
 acquit Exonerate and for ever discharge the said James Wall
 ce his heirs Executors and assigns by these presents shall give
 granted bargain sold and sold and conveyed made over Released
 Confirmed as by these presents to the said Robt Johnson doth for
 himself and his heirs give grant bargain sell alien Dispose
 make over Release and Confirm to the said James Wallace
 his heirs Executors assigns or Certain Attorney at law that tract
 or parcel of Land in Prince Georges County in the parish of
 Piscataway containing one hundred acres called Little ^{with} now in
 possession of the said Robert Johnson together with all Gardens
 Orchards pastures Woods Underwoods houses out houses Stables
 Barns and all other appurtenances and appurtenances
 whatsoever to the same belonging or in any ways appertaining
 or now reputed to belong appertaining as also four cows two
 calves and one two year old eight head of Hogs all marked
 with all Debts and Sums of money to be paid
 of 100 lb. upon the said plantation Litter belonging Bullocks
 in the said plantation and all other things whatsoever that the said Robt
 Johnson can proclaim as his together also with all the Inclosure
 of the above mentioned cattle and Hogs to have and hold the bargain
 sold premises and every part thereof and the said James
 Wallace his heirs and assigns for ever to the only proper Use
 behoofe of the said Wallace his heirs and assigns for ever to no
 other Use Intent or purpose whatsoever and the said Robt
 Johnson doth for him his heirs Executors and assigns
 promise to and with the said James Wallace his heirs
 assigns that the said Robert Johnson at the time of the
