This Indenture made this sixteenth day of —  
December 1707. BETWEEN George Yate of Pacl<sup>d</sup>  
County Planter Sonne and heir at Law of Geo: Yate —  
late of Anni<sup>e</sup> County Decd of the one parte and —  
Wm Johns of Calv<sup>t</sup> County Gent<sup>l</sup> of the other parte  
Witnesseth if whereas the Right Hon<sup>ble</sup> Cecilius —  
of noble memory late Lord and propri<sup>ty</sup> of this prvince  
did by his Letters patents bearing Date the tenth  
day of Sept<sup>r</sup> 1684 Did Grant unto y<sup>e</sup> Geo: Yate —  
all that tract of Land called Sway lying in —  
Calv<sup>t</sup> County on the West side of the north Branch  
of Puttug<sup>t</sup> River BEGINNING at a bound white  
oake by a branch called Marshy Branch and —  
bounding on the said Branch and running West —  
and by north one hundred and sixty p<sup>s</sup> to a marked  
oake from thence running South and by East three  
hundred and twenty p<sup>s</sup> to a bound oake by the —  
side of a branch called Cabbins branch & from —  
thence bounding on y<sup>e</sup> Branch lying Downe  
East and by north for ninety seven p<sup>s</sup> to the side  
of the w<sup>est</sup> north Branch of Puttugent River & —  
by y<sup>e</sup> Branch to the first bounded tree (onl<sup>y</sup>)  
and said out for two hundred acres of Land more  
or less and that afterwards (viz<sup>t</sup>) upon y<sup>e</sup> thirteenth  
day of Sept<sup>r</sup> sixteen hundred seventy & five for —  
the Consideration therein Expressed the s<sup>r</sup> George  
Yate the father did Bargaine and Convey the same —
