This Indenture made the eighth day of Septemb<sup>r</sup> in  
the seventh year of the Reigne of our Sovereign Lady  
Anne Queen of Great Brittain &c Annoq<sup>ue</sup> D<sup>omi</sup>ni one thousand  
seven and eight. Between Samuell Dyer of Annamundell  
County in the province of Maryland planter and Susannah  
his wife of the one part and Anna Garret of said County and  
province merchant of the other part whereas the Right Honourable  
Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore &c by his Letters patents  
bearing date the Feilday of March one thousand six hundred  
ninety and five did grant unto him the said Samuell Dyer  
of Annamundell County aft<sup>r</sup> all that Tract or parcel of Land  
called Dyers Inheritance lying on the west side of the north  
Branch of Patuxent River Beginning at a boundd Red  
oak standing by the said Branch it being a boundtree of  
Thomas Browne and running north fifty two degrees west  
eighty six per<sup>ts</sup> to a boundd red oak in a branch then north  
eighty degrees west two hundred fifty two per<sup>ts</sup> to a boundd  
white oak then north eighty six degrees east one hundred  
and twenty per<sup>ts</sup> to a boundd white oak standing by the  
said River then bounding on the said River running  
south five degrees east two hundred and seventy perches then  
by a straight Line to the first boundd Tree containing  
and now said out for two hundred fifty and four acres  
of Land (More or Less) According to the Cert<sup>ificat</sup> of Sur<sup>v</sup>
