Anne Queen of Great Brittain &c Annoq Dm^r one thousand
Seven and Eight Between Samuel Dryer of Antrimundell
County in the province of Maryland planter and susahali
his wife of the one part and Anna Garrett of said County
provincemach of the other part witness the Right Honorable
Charles Lord Baron of Baltimore &c by his letters patente
bearing date the tenth day of March One Thousand Six hundred
ninety and five did grant unto him the said Samuel Dryer
of Antrimundell County aft all that Tractor parcel of Land
called Dryers Inheritance lying on the west side of the north
Branch of Patapsco River Beginning at a boundred Red
oak standing by the said Branch it being a boundred tree
Thomas Brownes and running north sixtytwo degrees west
Eighty six per^r to a bound red oak in a branch thereunto
six degrees west Six hundred Sixty two per^r and boundred
little oaks then north Sixty six degrees East one hundred
and Twenty per^r to a bound white oak standing by the
said River then boundred on the said River running
south five degrees East Two hundred and Seven per^r thence
by a straight line to the first boundred tree abovemore
and now laid out for two hundred fifty and four acres
of Land / more or less / according to the Ext of the
same
