 enfeoff and consume unto him the said Amos Garrett his
 heirs and assigns all the of Two hundred fifty and four
 acres of Land called Dyers Inheritance to have hold
 the said two hundred fifty & four acres of Land & messuages
 called Dyers Inheritance wth all & singular the
 woods underwoods & Timber Trees orchards nurseries
 pastures meadows houses out houses and all other
 the appurtenances what soever thereunto belonging or in
 any wise appertaining unto him the said Amos
 Garrett his heirs past & for ever, And the said Sam^l Dyer
 & Susannah his wife for themselves & their heirs
 doth hereby covenant promise grant & agreed to and
 with the said Amos Garrett his heirs and assigns
 that they the said Samuel Dyer and Susannah
 his wife shall at all times from henceforth &
