County Gentleman of the other part Witnesseth  
that the said Abraham Clarke for and in Consideration  
of the sum of one hundred pounds Current and Lawfull  
money of England to him in hand well & Fully paid  
before Reciting and Delivery of these presents paid  
by the said Charles the receipt whereof he the said  
Abraham doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and every  
part thereof doth fully clearly & absolutely  
Exonerate acquit & Discharge him the said Charles from all  
his debts and assignes for ever. It All given granted  
Bargained Sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed as by these  
presence he doth give grant Bargain sell alien Enfess  
and Confirm unto him the said Charles Carroll his heirs and  
assignes for ever all that three hundred acres of Land being  
part of a dividend of land of four hundred acres formerly
