This Indenture made this Twentysixth Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Eight By and between Lewis Duval of Annarundell County Gent<sup>l</sup> of the one part and John Hyo of the City of London in the Kingdom of England merchant of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lewis for and in Consideration of the sum of five hundred pounds current and Lawfull money of England to him on hand at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said John Hyo well and truly paid the receipt whereof the said Lewis doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every part and parcel thereof doth fully clearly and absolutely exonerate acquit and Discharge him the said John Hyo his heirs Executors and administrators and every of them forever by these presents as also for divers other good causes and valuable Considerations in the premises especially moving the said Lewis doth given granted Bargained sold aliened Encoffed and Confirmed as by these presents he doth for him and his heirs give grant Bargain sell alienen Encoff and Confirm unto him the said John Hyo all that those severall Tracts or parcels or parts of Tracts herein after Described Viz<sup>t</sup> All that Tract or parcel of Land lying in Annarundell County aforesaid
