Marys County Gentlemen & firmly bound unto our  
Sovereign Lady the Queen that now is her heirs and successors  
in the full and just sume of Two hundred thousand pounds

which payment well and truly to be made we bind our selves  
us any either & every of us our heirs & executors and adm<sup>r</sup> joyntly  
severally in & for the whole firmly by these presents sealed with  
our Seals and Dated this 8<sup>th</sup> Day of October Anno 1707

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the  
above bound to me Goddard and truly serve her said Maj<sup>ys</sup>  
her heirs and successors in the office of High Sheriff of St  
Marys County within the province aforesaid and also shall render  
unto her Maj<sup>ys</sup> and other her officers a True and Just ac-  
count of all her Maj<sup>ys</sup> & her heirs & successors or to her and their Governor herefor  
the sume being for the sume of forfeitures and other dues  
belonging to her said Maj<sup>ys</sup> Government and also his acc-
