of attorney be it known and manifest unto all those who shall see
these presents or hear the same read that on the thirteenth day of
October Anno Domini 1712 and in the Eleventh year of the reign of our
Sovereign Lady Anne by the grace of God Queen of Great Britain
France and Ireland defender of the faith &c before me James Dunning
Notary and Councillor Publick residing in London duly admitted and
Sworne in the presence of the witnesses hereafter named Personally
Apparred Mr Thom: Wagle of London Merchant who declared to have
made ordained and Constituted and by these presents doth make Ordain
and constitute Mr Simon Wagle of Maryland Merchant at present in
London his true and Lawfull attorney giving and by these presents
Granting unto his Said attorney full power and lawfull authority for him
the Said Constituant in his name and to his use to aske demand Levy sue
for and by all Lawfull wayes and means recover and receive of and from
all and every such person or persons of what degree or Quality soever
whome it shall or may concerne all such Sums and Sums of money goods
wares Merchandises Effects Chattels and things whatsoever due owing
belonging or in any wise appertaining to and the Said Constituant
whether by bond note bill book debt acc^t Consequen^t or for or by what
other reason or means so ever nothing excepted nor reserved upon recoverys
and receipts legitt^m and or more Acquittances or other suff^t discharges
in due form of Law But in case of refusal or delay by any person or
persons whome it shall or may concerne to make and receive just and
true acc^t and payment and satisfaction in the premises him or them
thereunto to compell by all all Lawfull wayes and means whatsoever
Also if need be to appear before all Lords Judges and Justices in any
Court or Courts there to ans^r defend and reply in all matters and
Causes touching or concerning the premises to do say pursue Implead
Seize Sequester attach Imprison and to condemn and out of prison
again to deliver Also to Compound conclude and agree by Arbitratⁿ
or otherwise as his said attorney shall think fit and generally in and
Concerning the premises to do performe and execute all and whatsoever
shall be requisite and necessary as fully amply and Effectually to all
