twelfth day of May Anno dⁿⁱ 1713 and in the 13th year of our
Sovereign Lady Ann Queen of Great Britain and before us
Robert Torrens Notary publick by Royall authority admitted
and Sworne dwelling in London and in the presence of
under written witnesses personally appeared M^r. Andon
Carlton of London Merchant unto and Notary well known
which appeared in the first place revoking all former
proclamations or Letters of attorney by him heretofore made
that made ordained Consulted and appointed And by the
present doth make ordain Consulted and appoint M^r. John
Williamson of London Merchant but now bound out on a
Voyage to salutent River in Maryland on the Continent
of America to be his true and lawfull attorney Giving unto
him full power authority & speciall charge for and in the
name and to the purpose and behoof of him the Consultant
to ask demand sue for Levy recover and receive of and from
all and every such person or persons whom it doth or
may concern in Maryland and else where on the Continent
of America all such summs and summs of money debts goods
wares Merchandise Effects Estate and things now due or
belonging to the said Consultant or in any wise appertaining
to him to the same due or owing either by bill bond book
account bill or bills of Exchange Consignment or Consignment of
goods or otherwise howsoever for what cause or reason soever
