

This Indenture made the thirteenth
 day of March in the twelfth year of the reign of
 our Sovereign Lady Queen Anne of Great Brittain
 to Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and
 twelve. Between James Moore and Maeyling
 wife formerly the daughter of Wm. Rogers of the
 one part of Prince Georges County and Her: Raynes
 of the province of Maryland Merchants of the other
 part Witnesseth that the said James Moore for and
 in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds sterling money
 of Great Brittain to the said James Moore in hand
 paid by the said Her: Raynes before the Enscaling
 delivery hereof the receipt whereof the said James Moore
 doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and every part
 and part thereof doth hereby fully clearly and
 absolutely & ungenerally acquit and discharge him
 said Her: Raynes his heirs &c. and admit that the
 bargain and aliened Ensclosed and confirmed as
 by these presents he the said James Moore doth
 for himself and his heirs bargain sell alien
 Ensclose and confirm unto the said Herodiah
 Raynes all and every the hereafter mentioned
 fourth of a tract of Land &c. which a certain Jew
 Morgan late of the said Annapolis County deceased
 called Middle neck lying on the East Side of
 Chesapeake Bay and on a river in the said Bay
 called Sasapow river, and on the north Side of
 the river Beginning at a marked white Stake
 standing on a point, on the Eastern Side of a
 Creeke called Duck Creeke running from the
 Stake up the river Easterly one hundred and
 fifty perches to a marked pine standing on a
 bank side, by the mouth of a Creeke called Jones
 Creeke running from the said Pine by a line drawn
 (North)
