 C in Consideration of the sume of two hundred & sixtoun pounds  
 sterl to him in hand paid by the said Charles the receipt whereof he  
 said Duke doth hereby Acknowledges & thorow doth Acquitt and  
 Discharge him the said Charles hath given. Grasped bargained  
 sold aloncs Enforfed & Confermed unto him the said Charles  
 Carroll his heire & Assignes forever all that tract or parcole of  
 Land lying & boing in the said George County Called Spanish Land  
 originally granted unto Cap<sup>t</sup> ~~the~~<sup>John</sup> Gardiner late of this Province Dated for  
 Eight hundred acres being one hundred acres parte thereof to be  
 Conveyed to a certaine Richard Edelon also al that Seven hund  
 and Seventy three acres remaining unsold of a tract or Mannor  
 of Land Called Harberton Mannor Originally granted unto  
 Doctor Luke Barbour late of this province also Dated for Twelve  
 hundred acres lying ~~adjoining~~ in the said George County aforesaid  
 To eathir with all singular the right members and appurtenances  
 therounls belonging or appertaining to have and to hold  
 all the said Bargained Lands & promised unto him the said Charles  
 Carroll his heire & assignes forever to and for the only proper use  
 & behoife of him the said Charles his heire and Assignes and to no  
 other use entoil or purpose whatsoover And the said Duke doth  
 hereby for him & his heire <sup>and</sup> his heire promise grant & agree to &  
 will the said Charles his heire and Assignes that till the said  
 Bargained Lands promised & other the Appurtenances are at the time  
 of the Ensealing and Delivery of thos presents Cleare & free of & from  
 all manner of Incumbrances whatsoever save only the ditt wth wch  
 hereafter to go to Due to the Lord proprieetary for the time boing and  
 that the same against all persons whatsoever he will warrant defend  
 unto him the said Charles Carroll his heire and Assignes Provided  
 always & it doth true intollg meaneing of thos presents that if the  
 said Duke his heire Ex Adm<sup>r</sup> or Assignes shall wch affor  
 upon the second day of June next pay or cause to be paid unto  
 (him)
