This Indenture

made the sixteenth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fourteen Between Thomas Frisby of Cecil County Gent of the one part and Rachell Greenberry of Sumner County in the province of Maryland widow of the other part Witnesseth that the said Thomas Frisby for and in Consideration of the One hundred fifty two pounds fifteen shillings and money of Great Brittain to him in hand paid by the said Rachell the receipt whereof the said Tho: doth hereby acknowledge and thereof doth fully discharge the said Rachell her heirs etc and assigns hath bargained and sold conveyed & confirmed as by these presents he doth for himself and his heirs bargain sell conveyed and confirmed unto her the said Rachell Greenberry all that tract or parcels of land called Painters Rest lying on the North Side of Sasparax river at the head of the said river in Cecil County Beginning at a marked Chestnut tree standing on a branch by a Valley near the river side being an Easterly bounded tree of a parcel of land laid out for James Hill, and from thence bounded with the river on the South by a line drawn East South East seventy five feet to a marked red Oak standing on a bank by the river being the first bounded tree of the former Survey of the said Land and from the said red Oak bounded wth the river, and the main branch of the river by a line drawn East Southly four hundred seventy five feet to a marked red oak standing by the side of the branch respecting a fork of the branch on the opposite side and running from the said red Oak by a line drawn North East five hundred thirty two feet and from the end of the North East line by a line drawn west North west four hundred thirty two feet and from the end of the west North west line wth a straight line seven hundred and thirty feet to a first bounded Chestnut containing and layd out for the use of sixteen hundred and thirty Acres of Land more or less as the Certificate of Survey of said Land taken up for Nicholas Painter and dated the seventeenth day of December One thousand six hundred seventy eight, more fully and at large it doth and may appear And by the said Nicholas Painter by deed conveyed to the said Henry Lord of St Marys County and by said Lord by deed conveyed to Mr. John Burgess of Annapolis County, by the said John Burgess bequeathed (in will) to his son Henry Burgess and
