one hundred and fifty pounds Current money of
England making the Sum of two hundred pound
Current money of Maryland to him in hand paid
by the said Charles the receipt whereof the said
Thomas Doewra hereby acknowledge and therewith
doth hold himself fully satisfied & Contented
hath Given granted Bargained sold Aliened & confirmed
and confirmed as by these presents he doth for
himself and his heirs give grant Bargain
sell Aliene & confirmed unto him the
said Charles all that Lot of ground lying in Marbo-
rough Town and whereon the said Thomas Doewra hath built and
erected a Tann house or houses and placed a Tanyard toge-
ther with all Edifices Building Tann falls Bark house
Bark Mills and all other Utensils whatsoever for work-
ing thereunto belonging as alsoe eight hundred good neat
Leather Hides two hundred thereof being completely
+ Tanned and three hundred more in the same fall about
half tanned and remaining three hundred hides green
and newly brought into the said Tann Yard TO HAVE AND
to hold use occupy possess and Enjoy the said Lot of ground
together with all and singular the said Tann houses Tan-
yard and ~~and~~ ^{and} other if appertaininges thereunto belong-
ing or in any wise appertaining as alsoe the said number of
eight hundred hides in manner and forme as Tanned half
taned and Green lying and being in the Tann houses and
(Tanyard)
