 (by virtue of the powers given in and by the said
 Letters Patents and approbation aforesaid) constituted
 Nominated and appointed and by these Presents
 do constitute Nominate and appoint you the said
 John Hart to be Lieutenant and Chief Governour
 of the said province of Maryland & therein and
 hereby granting you full and absolute power and
 Authority to exercise execute and put in practice
 all and every the said powers jurisdictions and
 Authorities so granted in and by the said Letters
 Patents as aforesaid necessary and convenient for
 the defence Safety preservation wellbeing and
 good governing of the said province and generally
 to do execute and perform all and all manner
 of matters and things whatsoever requisite and
 necessary for the good order of Government —
 Administering, Maintaining, and executing of
 Justice and for the Security, Defence, Safety peace
 and Preservation of the said province and people
