himself therewith fully satisfied Contented and paid and thereof  
stand from every part and parcel thereof doth clearly acquit  
Exonerate and discharge the said Philimon Loyd Esq<sup>r</sup> his heirs  
Exors and Adms forever by these presents Hath given granted
