 of which the aforesaid Summes of Money were by my Father Brother Thomas
 Brown or the John Brown repaid unto the aforementioned Amos
 Garrett or unto any person or persons by his Ord^r therefore the said
 John Brown for and in Consideration that the said John am fully
 Satisfied that the aforesaid Summes of Money are Rightly due to him of
 said Amos and for and in Consideration besides or over and above
 the Just Summe of Eighty pounds Curr^t money to the aforesaid
 one in hand paid by the said Amos the receipt whereof the
 John doth hereby Acknowledge with the said Amos Garrett
 promising his Claim to the three Negroes that he has a Right
 by my Father and in order to their being appraised to
 Personal Estate thereby to Enable His said Son being
 John Brown Esq^r to pay some or all debts due from Tho^s
 my father and the overplus thereof to be shared as the Law
 is therefore the said John Brown by these presents do hereby
 give and forever Quit all Claimes that now have or hereafter
 he have of in and unto all and every parte and parcel of the eleven
 tracts of Land and premises conveyed over ~~by~~ by my late Father
 Thomas Browne their Names and Quantities here afore recited
 unto the aforesaid Amos Garrett his heirs and Assignes with also all
 manner of Interest Title Right Benefit or Advantage accruing
 to me in the aforesaid Land and premises by means of my Elder Brother
 Thomas Deed of Bargaine and Sale recorded aforesaid with
 also all manner of Interest property Right Benefit or Advantage
 by descent from my father Thomas Browne ^{or my brother Thomas} or any other Right
 Interest property that the said John have to the eleven tracts of
 Land or unto any parte or parcel thereof Lying in Baltimore
 and this County unto him the said Amos Garrett his heirs &
 Assignes forever and the said John Browne doth also for
 himselfe
