

This Indenture made this tenth Day of Sept: Seventeen  
 hundred and Sixteen Between Richard Smith of Parluxent  
 In Maryland Gent: of the one part and Charles Carroll of G.  
 City of Annapolis Esq: of the other part Witnesseth that G.  
 R. Richard for and in Consideration of the Sume of one hun-  
 dred twenty five pounds Sterl: to him in hand paid by the S<sup>r</sup>  
 Charles C. receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledge and there-  
 of doth acquit G. S<sup>r</sup> Charles his Ex<sup>r</sup> and Adm<sup>r</sup> hath given Grant  
 and Bargained sold Aliene Enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these  
 presents doth for himself and his heirs give Grant Bargaine sell  
 Alien Enfeoff and Confirm unto him the said Charles his heirs  
 and assigns for ever All that <sup>one</sup> moiety of a tract of Land  
 lying in Ballemore County and called by the name of the Val-  
 ley of Jehosaphath and Expressing by Patent to Containe two thou-  
 sand and two hundred acres the S<sup>r</sup> moiety being one thousand two  
 hundred & fifty acres and Disceided to him as heir at Law to  
 his father Capt: Richard Smith late of Saint Leonard's In  
 (Colon)
