This Indenture made this tenth day of October in the year of
 our Lord Seventeen hundred & Seventeen BETWEEN th Dorsey of
th of one part & th Carroll Esq^r of th of the other part
 witnesseth that th Dorsey for & in consideration of the sum
 of forty nine p^{ts}. Seventeen Shillings pence Curr^t money to him
 in hand paid before & receiving & delivery of these presents & receipt
 whereof he doth hereby acknowledge & thereof & of every part & parcel
 thereof doth fully clearly & absolutely recover and acquit and
 discharge him & said Charles Carroll with his heirs granted bargained
 sold aliened conveyed and confirmed & by these presents he doth give
 grant bargain sell alien convey & confirm unto the th Charles Carroll
 & his heirs a certain ^{piece} or parcel of Land called Hockley being one
 hundred acres formerly belonging to th & by him assigned
 Edmund Talbot whose assignee th father by Deed of Gift made
 over the said Land to his th Son th Lying in Baltimore County on
 the South side of the falls at the head of Patuxent river as also
 one Gray horse branded ^{on} near buttock a black mare branded
 on the near buttock a bay horse marked ^{on} on the near buttock a bay
 Mare branded ^{on} on the near buttock a Gray Mare branded ^{on} on the
 near buttock a dark bay mare branded ^{on} on the near buttock a small
 Horse branded ^{on} on the near buttock To have & To hold the th part
 of Land to the th Seven horses and Mares above mentioned unto him & th
 Charles Carroll his heirs & assigns for ever & th for himself and
 his heirs doth covenant promise grant & agree to give the th Charles
 Carroll
