 paid by the a<sup>d</sup> Henry Wright before the Ensealing and Delivery  
 of these presents & receipt whereof the a<sup>d</sup> John Brice does  
 hereby Acknowledge & thereof & therefrom & from every part  
 and parcel thereof doth freely fully & absolutely Exonerate  
 Acquit & Discharge the a<sup>d</sup> Henry Wright his heirs Ex<sup>rs</sup> & Adm<sup>rs</sup>  
 & every of them by these presents for their full & free Grant  
 Bargained Sold Alien'd Infeoffed Remist Released & Confirmed  
 and by these presents doth the a<sup>d</sup> Henry Wright Bargain Sell Alien  
 Infeoff remist release and Confirms to the a<sup>d</sup> Henry Wright his  
 heirs & assigns for ever All them two Tracts or parcels of Land  
 called Merikens Purchase and Point Look out Both which said  
 Tracts of Land was Bought of Joshua Meriken Jun<sup>r</sup> by John  
 Brice of Ann. County Merch<sup>t</sup> as by an Indenture under the  
 hand of a<sup>d</sup> Meriken bearing date & Eighteen Day May 1710  
 and by the a<sup>d</sup> John Brice in his will bearing Date the Eight  
 day of Decem<sup>r</sup> 1713) Bequeath the a<sup>d</sup> two tracts of Land to the
