 drawn and the said Christopher Rowby not having first been Stricken  
 the said George Talbot feloniously an assault did make and that the  
 said George Talbot with a certaine Dagger made of Iron and Steel of  
 the Value of One shilling which he the said George Talbot in his right hand  
 then and there had and held the same up, the said Christopher Rowby then  
 and there not having any weapon drawn, and the said Christopher  
 Rowby then and there not having first Stricken the said George  
 Talbot feloniously then & therein and upon the right breast the said  
 Christopher Rowby did stab and thrust giving to him the said  
 Christopher Rowby then and there with the dagger aforesaid in Manner  
 aforesaid one deadly wound in and upon the right breast of Christopher  
 Rowby aforesaid then & there instantly dyed &c. &c. so the Jurors aforesaid  
 say upon their Oathes that the said George Talbot the said Christopher  
 Rowby the said One and thirty all Day of October in the year aforesaid on  
 board the Ketch aforesaid in Manner and forme aforesaid feloniously did kill against  
 the Peace of our said Sovereign Lord the King his Coronation and Dignity  
 and against the forme of the Statute in such Cases made and provided  
 Guilty Wm Kendall foreman *Billa vera*
