 Hall in St John Street in the said County between the hours of Nine o'Clock
 twelve in the forenoon of the same day and produced and deliver-
 in Open Court a Certificate in writing of his receiving the Parson-
 of the Lords Supper in a Protestant reformed Congregation in
 this Kingdom of Great Brittain within three months past next
 before the exhibiting such Certificate signed by the person adminis-
 -tring such Sacrament and attested by two Credible Witnesses -
 in Pursuance of an Act of Parliamt. made in the Seventh year
 of her said Majestys Reigne intituled an Act for Naturalizing -
 Foreign Protestants and then there took and subscribed
 the Oaths and made repeated and subscribed the Oaths appointed
 by Act of Parliamt. made in the Sixth year of her said Majestys
 Reigne intituled an Act to make further Provision for
 calling and Summoning sixteen Peers of Scotland to sit in the
 house of Peers in the Parliamt. of Great Brittain and for
 trying Peers for offences committed in Scotland and for the
 further Regulating of Voters in Elections of members to sit
