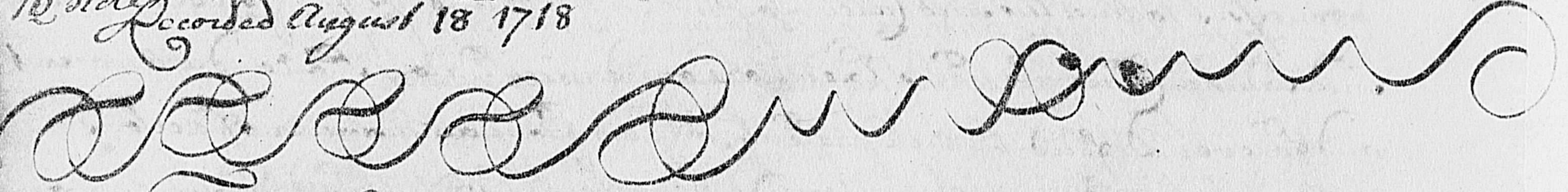

This Indenture Made the Twentysixth Day of June in the fourth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third Annoque Domini one Thousand Seven hundred and Eighteen between Samuel Chew of the County of Ann Arundel in the Province of Maryland Gent of the One part and Caleb Dorsey of the same place Gent on the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Chew for and in consideration of the Sum of three hundred pounds good and Lawfull Money of England to him in hand paid at and before the Executing and Delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge and forever therefrom acquit and Discharge the said Caleb Dorsey his heirs and Administrators by these presents have given granted bargained sold Enjoyned and Confirmed and by these presents give grant bargain Sell Enjoyned and Confirmed unto the said Caleb Dorsey his heirs and Assignes forever All that Tract or parcel of Land
