 Land one or before the twentieth Day of July next ensuing at
 also all Law Charges one Containd in the above Commissions as the
 said George Brion the said Part of Land of none effect and the Land
 and premises therein first mentioned of the said and old stock to the same and
 to all intents and purposes whatsoever in witness whereof the parties have
